REDWIND TO OFFER MONEY SMART WORKSHOP FOR SMALL BUSINESS IN MASHPEE, MASSACHUSETTS

Mashpee, MA – RedWind is thrilled to hold its next workshop, hosted by the Employment and Training Division of the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribe. This small business development workshop will be provided at the Quashnet Valley Country Club located at 309 Barnstable Road in Mashpee, Massachusetts 02649, on Thursday, July 30th and Friday, July 31st, 9:00am-4:00pm.

All Native entrepreneurs are invited to attend and strongly encouraged to register for this FREE two-day course for small business development. The training workshop will benefit anyone who operates or is considering operating a small business.

This Money Smart Workshop for small business, one of (5) RedWind will hold this year, is an instructor-led training curriculum developed jointly by FDIC and SBA. The 10 modules in this curriculum provide introductory training for new and aspiring entrepreneurs on the basics to organizing and managing a business. In addition to grounding participants in the basics, the curriculum serves as a foundation for more advanced training and technical assistance.

RedWind will present this training in partnership with the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribe's Employment and Training Division. The event is free to attend and open to the public. All class materials and refreshments will be provided to participants at no cost.

Yvonne Marie Tobey, the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribe's Director of the Employment & Training Division stated, "One of our goals is to support and enhance our communities by providing technical assistance for the development of small businesses.
